Browns Valley Regular City Council Meeting Approved Minutes April 28, 2025



The regular council meeting of the City of Browns Valley, MN, was held in the meeting room of the Public Library. Council members present were Mayor Mike Heck, Tony Miller, Michael Backer, Devan Dobbs, and Jan Biewer. Also in attendance were City Maintenance Supervisor Tony Serocki, City Administrator Jodi Hook-Hansen, Library Director Bernice Piechowski, Code Enforcement Officer Terry Biewer and City Attorney Matt Franzese

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Mayor Heck The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

Agenda:

> Upon a motion by Biewer, seconded by Backer, the Council unanimously approved the agenda.

Consent Agenda:

- ➤ Upon a motion by Backer, seconded by Biewer, the Council unanimously approved the April 14, 2025, Regular Meeting Minutes.
- ➤ Upon a motion by Backer, seconded by Biewer, the Council unanimously approved the April 7th, 2025, Board of Appeal and Equalization Meeting Minutes.
- ➤ Upon a motion by Biewer, seconded by Backer, the Council unanimously approved the claims totaling \$57,752.02, including wages (April 16th = \$7428.59) and claims (April 28 = \$50,323.43).
- ➤ Upon a motion by Dobbs, seconded by Backer, the Council unanimously approved Resolution 25-08, a resolution accepting a \$400.00 donation to the City from the Township of Browns Valley. The Council expressed their appreciation for the donation.

Department Reports:

- Library Director Piechowski reported on activities at the library.
- City Maintenance Supervisor Serocki reported on completed and ongoing public works projects.
 He informed the council about trees in the ditch that require removal and received authorization
 to proceed with hiring Goodhart Excavating for the cleanup.
 Serocki also informed the Council that the plow truck wiring is not working and asked to take it
 to Bert's Truck Equipment in Moorehead, Minnesota.
- Code Enforcement Officer Biewer reported on actions taken to enforce City ordinances and items completed in the office.
- City Administrator Hook-Hansen reported on administrative items completed in the office.
- City Attorney Franzese gave a verbal report on actions performed for the City of Browns Valley.

Unfinished Business:

Browns Valley Regular City Council Meeting Approved Minutes April 28, 2025

> Upon a motion by Miller, seconded by Backer, the Council unanimously approved hiring Lapp Roof Restoration to repair half of the Community Center roof using spray fiberglass, at a total cost of \$22,752.14. The project will be funded with an insurance replacement check in the amount of \$21,752.14, with the remaining \$1,000.00 to be covered by the City's insurance deductible.

New Business:

Request for Approval of Maintenance and Upgrades

- A request was presented for approval of the following work to be completed by Great Plains Structures: Interior Resealing – Re-seal the interior structure with an estimated cost of \$62,130.00.
- Cathodic Protection Install magnesium anodes for cathodic protection to help prevent corrosion, with an estimated cost of \$2,800.00.
- GS-9 Mixer Installation Install a GS-9 Mixer to mitigate ice formation and protect the newly applied sealer from damage, with an estimated cost of \$15,600.00.

Total estimated cost: \$80,530.00.

- > Upon a motion by Dobbs, seconded by Biewer, the Council unanimously approved proceeding with the installation of magnesium anodes for cathodic protection at an estimated cost of \$2,800.00, and to include the remaining upgrades in future budget planning to preserve the water tower.
- > Upon a motion by Dobbs, seconded by Miller, the Council unanimously approved Building Permit for 714 W Broadway, submitted by Aaron Hickman.
- > Upon a motion by Miller, seconded by Biewer, the Council unanimously approved entering into a new Land Lease Agreement with Aaron Hickman, effective July 1, 2025, and renewing the existing Land Lease Agreement with Brian Hanson, also effective July 1, 2025. Both agreements are for a one-year term, ending July 1, 2026.
- > Council Members Tony Miller and Devan Dobbs will represent the City by joining a joint building committee with Traverse County and the City of Wheaton. The committee will address joint costsharing efforts related to the demolition of properties.

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 92.03(I)(1) AND (2)

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF TREES IN THE CITY OF BROWNS VALLEY

Findings.

- 1. The Browns Valley City Council has a provision defining certain diseased trees as public nuisances.
- 2. It has come to the attention of the Browns Valley City Council that there is an additional issue with trees overhanging onto city streets and city rights-of-way.
- 3. The Browns Valley City Council believes it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Browns Valley to amend its Ordinance declaring certain trees a public nuisance to include those trees that are overhanging onto city streets and city rights-of-way.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROWNS VALLEY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Browns Valley City Ordinance Section 92.03(I)(1) and (2) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(I) Nuisance

For Review

(1) Defined.

- (a) Any living or standing tree or part thereof infected to any degree with an infectious disease or which harbors any insect, fungi, or virus known to contribute to the spread of such disease is hereby declared to be a public nuisance.
- (b) Any dead tree or part thereof known to contribute to the spread of infectious diseases, including logs, branches, stumps, or firewood, is hereby declared to be a public nuisance.
- (c) Any tree living or standing or dead which overhangs into the streets nearer than eight feet above the ground or fourteen feet above the improved street or alley.
- (d) This provision shall not apply to those diseases already covered under Section 92.02

(2) Nuisance Prohibited. I

(a) It shall be unlawful for the owner of any parcel of land in the City to permit or maintain on any such parcel of land or upon abutting street right of way any tree or dead wood which is a public

nuisance as defined in Section 92.15. It shall be the duty of any such owner to promptly abate the nuisance by removing and destroying such tree or dead wood in a manner authorized by the city manager or his duly authorized representative.

(b) Upon any complaint being made to the Public Works Director, any violation of section 1(c) above, of this ordinance, the Director shall visit the premises on which it is claimed such trees are untrimmed. If said complaint is well founded the trees, the Director shall cause a written notice to be issued to the property owner, giving the property owner fourteen (14) days to correct the nuisance. If after fourteen (14) days the nuisance has not been abated, the trees shall be trimmed in accordance with said Section 1(c) and report the cost of the labor performed in connection therewith to the City Council. The City Council shall cause the same to be included in the taxes against the lot or lots on which said trees are standing or if standing in the street, shall cause the same to be included in the taxes against the lot fronting on the side of the street where said trees stand.
