



Browns Valley Regular City Council Meeting Approved Minutes May 26, 2026

The regular council meeting of the City of Browns Valley, MN, was held in the meeting room of the Public Library. Council members present were Mayor Mike Heck, Jan Biewer, Tony Miller, and Jerry Johnson. Also in attendance were Library Director Bernice Piechowski, City Maintenance Supervisor Tony Serocki, City Administrator Jodi Hook-Hansen, and Code Enforcement Officer Terry Biewer.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Mayor Heck.
The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

Agenda:

- Upon a motion by Biewer, seconded by Johnson, the Council unanimously approved the agenda.

Consent Agenda:

- Upon a motion by Biewer, seconded by Johnson, the Council unanimously approved the May 11th, 2026, Regular Meeting Minutes.
- Upon a motion by Johnson, seconded by Miller, the Council unanimously approved the claims totaling \$38,316.90, including wages (May 15th = \$8,583.67), and claims (May 26th = \$29,733.23).

Department Reports:

- City Administrator Hook-Hansen reported on administrative activities.
- Library Director Piechowski reported on library activities.
- City Maintenance Supervisor Serocki reported on public works projects.
- Upon a motion by Miller, seconded by Biewer, the Council unanimously approved authorizing City Maintenance Supervisor Tony Serocki to pull Well No. 3 to determine the source of the water leak.
- Upon a motion by Miller, seconded by Johnson, the Council unanimously approved adjusting the water usage billing related to the leak to the customer's average usage due to a faulty fitting that had been installed.
- Code Enforcement Officer Biewer reported on actions taken to enforce City ordinances and items completed in the office.

Unfinished Business: None

New Business:

- Upon a motion by Miller, seconded by Biewer, the Council unanimously approved the purchase of mosquito control product at a cost of \$2,350.00 per drum.
- The City Council helped identify community priorities and needs and provided input on financial goals and spending priorities. Council Members Heck and Miller will review and discuss the budgeting needs with City staff on Monday, June 1.

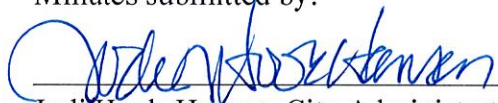
